

Partnership Regulations: Career Academy-Focus on Anatomy & Physiology Doylestown Hospital

Students enrolled in Anatomy & Physiology will travel to the Doylestown Hospital by school transportation from Central Bucks East and Central Bucks South. Students will return to their respective schools in time for their third block class.

Central Bucks School District Career Academy Program requires that all students must follow the school board policy for attendance and lateness while attending off-campus courses. If a student is absent or late, an excuse note must be provided in order to enter the next day's class period.

Guidelines for student participants in this program are as follows:

- ❑ Students are expected to follow Doylestown Hospital procedures, attend orientation at the hospital, and receive a PPD test for tuberculosis at Doylestown Hospital before rotations begin.
- ❑ When on rotations, all students are expected to be attentive and mindful of the preceptor's busy daily routine and be attentive.
- ❑ Patient privacy and confidentiality must be respected at all times.
- ❑ Students should be particularly considerate of any patients they observe undergoing procedures.
- ❑ Students should be polite at all time to anyone they encounter along the daily hospital routine.
- ❑ Students will dress in clothing that is professional, neat and in good taste. Hospital lab jackets will be worn while on rotation.
- ❑ Jeans are **never** acceptable and closed toed shoes are required. No flip-flops or sandals. ***Any student who is inappropriately dressed will not be allowed to participate in rotations for that day.***
- ❑ Long hair must be tied back for safety reasons.
- ❑ Students will abide by the classroom regulations provided by the teachers of this program.
- ❑ Classroom teachers will provide guidelines for closing of this course.

Students participating in the Anatomy & Physiology Career Academy agree to:

- ⇒ **Attend Doylestown Hospital's orientation session.**
- ⇒ **PPD skin test for tuberculosis (performed at Doylestown Hospital)**
- ⇒ **Transportation from Doylestown Hospital Monday and Tuesday during the second marking period.**
