

**Central Bucks Partnership Regulations:
Career Academy PVNC—Focus Environmental Biology**

Central Bucks School District Career Academy Program believes that all students must follow the school board policy for attendance and lateness while attending off campus courses. Students enrolled in the Peace Valley Nature Center program will travel by their own transportation the center and be on time for the first block session.

- All clothing must be appropriate for the outdoors and in good taste.
- Clothing that exposes the abdomen or midriff is unacceptable.
- Long pants are preferred because of walking in the outdoors.
- Tee tops must cover the abdomen and not be suggestive
- Jeans are acceptable but must be appropriate for the conditions.
- Shorts are not advisable in any of the sessions.
- Shoes must have closed toes; flip-flops or sandals are not advised because of trail walking and stream testing.
- Students must be on time and must check in with the classroom teacher each day and be ready for fieldwork by 7:35 a.m.
- Students must provide their own transportation and provide parental permission to drive to the PVNC.
- Students must be respectful of the PVNC staff giving lectures as they travel throughout the outdoor classroom and keep careful notes in a daily log—summarizing the day's journey.
- Students must work closely with the teacher on site if any problems occur during the session.
- Students must return promptly from the PVNC to their respective schools on time for the second block class.
- Lateness is not permitted—should one occur student must present an excuse signed by the parents on the next day of class.
- More than one excused lateness may jeopardize student participation in the program.
