MRSA UPDATE

Recently there have been a number of reports about Methicillin-Resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA) infections in schools. We have posted information regarding MRSA on the district website. The information contained below is to inform you of what regularly occurs in the schools in an effort to manage bacterial outbreaks and to provide you with suggestions to be followed at home. In the schools:



- Restrooms are disinfected daily.
- Locker rooms are disinfected daily.
- Team rooms are disinfected daily.
- Artificial turf at War Memorial Field is disinfected weekly.
- Those who supervise the weight room are to instruct users to disinfect their hands with gel when they leave and to disinfect the machines before and after use.

Although most infections are treatable, prevention is the key. You can help minimize the spread of staph infections by reinforcing the following good hygiene habits at home:

- Keep hands clean by washing thoroughly with soap and water or by using an alcohol-based hand gel.
- Take a shower after a sports practice or game.
- Keep cuts and scrapes clean and covered with a bandage until healed.
- Avoid contact with other people's wounds or bandages.
- Avoid sharing personal items such as towels, clothing or razors.
- Consult your health care provider if you have a question about the condition of a wound.
