Proposed Walking Zones

The School Board is considering expanding walking zones as a cost-savings measure. Some students at West, Gayman, South, Titus, Warwick, Lenape and Kutz will become walkers if the decision is approved. The areas in question are posted on the district homepage. The Board will be hearing public comment on the issue at the May 11 board meeting.

Relay Update

It is hard to believe that the date for the 2010 American Cancer Society Relay For Life of the Central Bucks Middle Schools is almost here. It is already shaping up to be a record setting year. We will cross the one million dollar fundraising mark. There are over 3,100 students registered, or two thirds of our middle school students. Over 400 cancer survivors and caregivers plan to join us in the celebration.



If you are planning to chaperone, please make sure you are registered online. Even if you are just helping with set-up, you must be registered to enter the track area.

We are thrilled that so many people want to help us celebrate, but it does present some challenges, and the biggest of those is parking. If you are coming to Relay, **you must carpool!** Some of you will be able to park in the Tohickon lot, but most will park at the remote lots at Groveland Elementary, Gayman Elementary or Penn Engineering. Shuttle buses will run ALL DAY from Tohickon to these remote lots. Unless you are a first shift chaperone who finds a parking spot at Tohickon, all students who are being dropped off in the morning should be dropped at Groveland. Supervised shuttles will take the students to Tohickon. Chaperones coming later in the day can park at either one of the remote lots and take the shuttle.

At dismissal, if your car is parked at Tohickon, take as many students as will fit safely in your car and drive out of Tohickon. Do not make arrangements for other parents to meet you at Tohickon. We don't want any more cars coming in when everyone else is trying to leave. If your car is at another parking lot, take your students on the shuttle to the other lot. Make arrangements to meet other parents there or perhaps in a neutral location.

A little advance planning for transportation will make the day go more smoothly for everyone. A PowerPoint with additional information from the chaperone meeting is now posted on the Relay webpage.
