Registration for New Students

Last year we had a substantial number of families who registered new students very late in the summer. This creates problems with class size and staffing our schools. If you have a friend or neighbor who needs to register a kindergarten or new student for the 2010—2011 school year, or if you need to register your own child, here is the pertinent information:



Do not wait until the summer to register your kindergarten or new student. Kindergarten Registration is now open and is ongoing through March 12, 2010. To be eligible for Kindergarten, a child must be 5 years of age before Sept. 1, 2010. For children who will be entering a CB school for the first time in the fall of 2010 as a first grader, the child must be 6 years of age before Sept. 1, 2010 or have completed a state approved kindergarten program. New Student Registration for grades 1-12 will begin Feb. 1, 2010. All registrations are conducted by Central Registration at 16 Welden Drive, by appointment only. Contact information is on the website.
